The First World War is over and Jacob Mercer has returned to Colley's Point, Newfoundland from Toronto to win the heart of Mary Snow. Under the light of the moon, these two former lovers confront their past

choices and contemplate a possible future. Truly romantic, and told with great charm and humour, *Salt-Water Moon* is a glimpse of Eden caught in the moonlight over Newfoundland and Labrador. One of David French's Mercer Plays along with *Leaving Home*, *Of The Fields*, *Lately*, 1949, and *Soldier's Heart*, and a Dora Mavor Moore Award winner. It is the gentlest play in the Mercer cycle, and is considered by many to be the best of the Mercer Plays and, perhaps, of the entire David French canon.

On the evening before her wedding in 1920, Mary looks back to 1914 when she first met Charlie and discovered the innocence and humour of first love. *Mary's Wedding* by Stephen Massicotte is a moving, lyrical

memory play exploring the relationship between a young farmer and a recent English immigrant to Canada in the early 20th century. Highlighting the enduring power of love, *Mary's Wedding* won the Alberta Playwriting Competition in 2000, and has since been produced multiple times in theatres across Canada, including at the National Arts Centre, as well as the United States, England, and Scotland.
